Happy summer sewing days!!! I started the summer by going to the Minnesota Quilt Show in St. Cloud. My husband came with and we had our camper in the campgrounds about 5 minutes away from the site of the show. I took 5 half day classes and each one was excellent. They had a special lectures pass. For \$25 you could go to any or all of the 13 lectures. My sister-in-law, Char, and I attended five. Great savings!! On Wednesday morning, Sally Terry taught a beginning longarm class. They provided a new Bernina longarm to share. It was very educational and the Bernina longarm sewed like a dream. Thursday morning, my class was "Hole in the Wall Runner". For \$20, they gave us a kit. It included the front pieces *cut out*, the batting, and the backing. Plus they provided Babylock teachers and sergers. The runner was adapted from an Eleanor Burns pattern which they also gave to us. What a deal!!! Friday morning, I took "Beginning Hand Quilting" from Andi Perejda. I learned a lot even though I only quilted 2 leaves in the class. She taught us what kind of fabric, batting, marking pencils, needles, thimble, hoop, and thread to use. She gave us a pattern, which we transferred to our fabric. Then we sewed it together and sewed by hand. I had some problems with the way she quilted, so had to adapt to what was comfortable for me. That afternoon, I took "Fabric Inking: Textures, Stencils, and Color Blending" from Joyce Teng. She was a hoot and we had a delightful time learning how to dye fabric using shaving cream. Char and I had a great time checking out two rooms of guilt shows, and the 200 or so vendors. Wow! What fun! Saturday morning I took "Sunday Drive

Tablerunner" from Doug Leko of Antler Quilt Design. He is from the twin cities. In the middle of this class, they called my name and I became proud the owner of the grand prize –a Janome Magnolia sewing machine. I was speechless. Sew Blessed Since our grandchildren live in Osseo, MN, we moved our camper from St. Cloud to Maple Grove campground. It was great spending time with the family. We even got to see our grandson play tball. That has so much fun. Sew Blessed After I got home I had to finish everything and I am happy to say I have the two tablerunner tops sewed together, and the hand sewed project hand stitched.
